I want to inform you about Pyramid Press, Owner Angel Gonzalez, and Isaac Galvin.

Mr. Gonzalez, and Mr. Galvin continue to use blackmail tactics on political candidates, and elected officials if they don't use their service for political campaigns.

Mr. Galvin is now a Compton City Councilman, Representing District 2. Prior to becoming a City Councilman, Galvin was an employee of Pyramid Printing. Mr. Gonzalez is Councilman Galvin (Field Liaison). However the conflict of interest appears when their using city money (time, office, and computers) to work on their candidates campaign material.

Its interesting that Mr. Galvin employed his boss, and in return Mr. Gonzalez kept his boss Mr. Galvin on payroll. I never imagined that an elected representative could employ a person that he works for and as a favor hire them as their staff person.

Mr. Galvin has recently threaten to blackmail a few political figures, making up outrageous rumors, and using his employer/ liaison to use campaign mailer to discredit candidates.

Pyramid Press has a history of fraud, corruption, and carrying out violent acts against elected official. I understand that your office has launched an official inquiry within the Central Basin Municipal Water District in particular Director Leticia Vasquez.

However Mr. Gavlin has a role in that case, he works for her political consultant Angel Gonzalez. They are calling this crew the "Latino Takeover" in government. Rick Mayer, and Angel Gonzalez use fear tactics, they are falsifying addresses, and running for seats (Isaac Galvin), and nevertheless these acts need to stop, and need to be thoroughly investigated. In March 2013 Mr. Galvin hit Mayor Leon- City of Commerce. Mayor Leon didn't file charges because of political interest (money) as the Office Public information stated. Mayor Leon only filed a report to be documented.

As a concerned citizen I urge the PIU unit (Public Integrity Unit) to further investigate Mr. Galvin. Mr. Galvin has been hostile towards colleagues, and other African American elected leaders. This combative behavior, and unethical morals will detour the City from moving forward to a positive image.
